Missionaries and Churches

LINKS

The LINKS program of the Church of the Nazarene is a network of personal connections between missionaries and Nazarenes around the world. Missionaries are assigned to districts and then on the district level, connected to local churches. This gives each church an opportunity to become personally acquainted with the missionary family and their field of service. Typically, churches send cards, email communications, and special remembrances to their LINKS missionaries.

In return, the churches feel a sense of involvement with the global mission enterprise of the church through regular correspondence from the missionaries, updates from their field, and even the possibility of deputation services while the missionaries are on home assignment. The missionaries are encouraged, knowing people care and pray for them. The relationships build over time personalize names and faces that both the missionaries and their LINKS churches value highly.

Local Church responsibilities:

Pray specifically and effectively for missions, especially the missionary assigned to you. Retired missionaries assigned have served a minimum of 25 years. All others are currently actively serving on their assigned field. Remember, the **most important** thing is **prayer**.

A LINKS cash gift may be given for personal needs. Birthdays, anniversary, Christmas, and other gifts are in addition. A cash assignment is not made but if your church wishes to give them a cash gift it must be sent online through [FundingTheMission.org](https://www.fundingthemission.org)

You Should --

Pray regularly for your LINKS missionaries and their work during church services, prayer meetings, mission services, and personal prayer times.

Correspond regularly with your LINKS missionaries, assuring them of your prayers and support. Their birthday and anniversary dates have been included. Cards are always appreciated. Correspondence can be by postal letter, cards, email, etc. Your first correspondence should be via email. You may ask them to provide you with their postal address for future postal correspondence.

Inform missionaries when sending a package, so they will know the date it was sent and what the package included. Except for children, money may be the best option. When sending a package ask the missionary before you send if they can receive packages and the best way to send them. Be sure to send in Duty money to Global Treasury Services.

Appoint one contact person who will correspond with the missionaries and share responses with the church. Do not expect a missionary to respond to every card and letter. NMI suggests that missionaries correspond quarterly and to acknowledge the receipt of packages .

Send all LINKS money (assignment amount, as well as any additional cash gifts) to Global Treasury Services in Kansas City for Approved Mission Special Credit. Gifts sent directly to missionaries are not eligible for Ten Percent Credit.

When Contacting Missionaries ...

- Do not use titles (e.g. Rev., Dr., Pastor, missionary, etc.) of any kind for missionaries in any format (e.g. Internet, ground mail).
- Use plain envelopes, not church stationery. Some countries are not receptive of the Gospel. Letters pass through many hands before their arrival.
- Contact the missionary about sending e-mail attachments. Are there limitations (e.g. cost, size, content) for attachments, or are attachments even accepted? Many missionaries are not on highspeed connections and cannot handle attachments.
- Remove special signatures, backgrounds, happy faces, etc. These take up time and space and can cost money to access them.
- Be aware of our personnel insensitive areas. If a missionary is not on the WM Web site (www.nazareneworldmission.org) under the link "Missionary Profiles," do NOT place their photos, bios, or even names on ANY Web site or in print. This will provide them maximum security. If they are not on the GM site, any mail or e-mail sent to them should NOT reference ministry activities or have religious phrases. Do not use the term missionary, ministry, evangelism, etc.
- Please do not forward articles and photos to the missionaries. This can be expensive and slows down their computers, preventing important e-mail connected with their responsibilities.
- Keep your communication personal, short, and sweet (concise and positive). Avoid mentioning people groups and negative public information. Always be positive and to the point.

BEFORE SENDING PACKAGES --

Communicate with your missionary to ask if they are able to receive packages and if so, how they should be sent. Follow their instructions carefully. Do not send packages without first checking with the missionary and sending in funds to cover duty on the package.
